We will drive into the park from Niagara Street on the ramp-like entrance next to 1726 Niagara Street, Buffalo. It's a short block north of the Niagara Street/Scajaquada intersection. The entrance has a large billboard and a small park sign. From the park entrance, cross the bridge spanning the Black Rock Canal (making sure that no one is already on the bridge as it has only one lane). Then drive straight ahead (west) to the river. Turn right under the International Railroad Bridge and drive to the parking area at the end of the road where we will start our work.
